Dear Indian Hollow Family,

The 100th Day of School is rapidly approaching. At this time, it falls on Thursday, February 14; the IH 100th Day Museum is scheduled for February 14. In celebration of this day, we are requesting that all students work with their families to create a 100th Day Project. If you wish, siblings may work together on the same project. Classroom teachers will provide some ideas to help the children get started. The following are guidelines for completing this task:

- Although parents may help, projects should be **created by the children**.
- Projects must contain 100 items and lots of imagination!
- **Projects should not be larger than the children can carry themselves**.
- Please send your project in a plastic garbage bag for ease of transportation to and from school, even if it can be rolled up. Please write your child's name on the garbage bag in permanent marker so it can be easily identified.
- Families must attach the enclosed "My 100th Day Project" sheet to their creations.

This year, we will have a preview time to visit the museum for all who are not able to attend during the school day. The preview time will be Wednesday, February 13 from 3:45 until 8:00 p.m. All projects will be showcased at our 100th Day Museum in the gymnasium on Thursday, February 14, regardless of any changes in the actual 100th Day due to unpredictable snow days. **All projects should be brought to school by your child on Wednesday, February 13.**

Please have your child wear his/her colored field trip T-shirt on **Thursday, Feb. 14**, to make it easy to keep track of the children during the museum visit. We invite you to join your child's class at its scheduled time to view all the wonderful museum projects. Please see the schedule for the Museum on the reverse side of this letter.

For your convenience, additional parking will be available in the back parking lot. Due to safety concerns and space limitations, strollers will not be permitted in the gymnasium. We thank you for your continued support and look forward to seeing you on Thursday, February 14!
