Dear Parents,

This year at Wood Park we continuing to instituting our new school wide positive behavior system called the Principal's 200 Club. Your children were introduced to this recently during a school wide assembly. The Principal's 200 Club is a school wide positive behavior support program that rewards and acknowledges students for following school rules and demonstrating good character. Students who are "caught" following the school-wide rules and exhibiting our "7 Habits" choose a ticket that is redeemed in the principal's office for a small token of appreciation and a chance to randomly choose a number card for the Principal's 200 Club board.

The contest is similar to bingo in that the board has numbered squares where students place their name in a square that coincides with the randomly drawn numbered card. Once an entire row is filled those students whose names appear in those boxes in the winning row will receive the Principal's Mystery Motivator reward. Upon completion of a cycle, the board will be wiped clean and the process will start again. The intended result of the Principal's 200 Club is increased positive behavior.

Please ask your children about this at home, and reinforce and remind them to continue to make good choices.
