FIRST AID



Newsday has been advised that, in accordance with the rules of the Nassau County Regional EMS Council, Emergency Medical Services Staff will be strictly following the guidelines of the NYS EMS protocol during the three nights they provide standby service at the Newsday Marching Band Festival. This means that if they provide treatment to a minor, **the only person who may sign the patient care report is a parent or legal guardian.** This applies to all forms of treatment. If a parent or legal guardian is not available, the only alternative that the Emergency Medical Services staff has is to transport the student to the nearest hospital. The hospital staff would then contact a parent.

We've been advised that there will be NO exceptions to this policy. In addition, **a permission slip from a parent is NOT valid.** **The signature on the patient care report must be that of a parent or legal guardian.**

Please be sure that all school staff or school escorts are aware of this policy should they have to bring a student for care.
