2024 STEM Scholarship

General Information

The Brookhaven National Laboratory Hispanic Heritage Group is pleased to announce that it will be granting financial awards from \$250 to \$1,000 each to students of Hispanic heritage pursuing a career in one of the STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering or Math) disciplines. Scholarship winners will be notified by June 10, 2024.

Who is Eligible?

Applicants who meet the following criteria are eligible to apply.

1. Hispanic Heritage.
2. Current high school senior residing in Suffolk or Nassau County.
3. Enrolling as a full-time college or university student for the 2024–25 academic year.
4. Declaring a major in a STEM discipline.
5. Minimum cumulative GPA of 85 (3.0 on a 4.0 scale).
6. Winners are expected to attend online scholarship ceremony if selected to receive a scholarship.

Application Submission Instructions

To minimize the risk of identity theft, and to protect applicants, any application materials must have all social security numbers and /or dates of birth removed (**blanked out/blackened out, made illegible, etc.**) prior to submittal.

Complete application package includes the following:

	Official High School Transcript submitted by the guidance counselor on or before May 17, 2024. Transcripts must be mailed directly by the guidance counselor to: HHGScholarship@bnl.gov .
	Attach your college/university acceptance letter or list of schools you have applied to.
	Applicant Information (page #3 of this document)
	Attach a list and brief description of each of the following: a. Extracurricular Activities (May include both academic and athletic activities) b. Community Service Activities (Include the approximate dates and length of time of involvement) c. Honors and/or Awards (Academic or extracurricular achievements)
	Letter of Recommendation from two (2) adults, not related to the applicant. The letter must include the following: a. Applicant's full name b. Name, Position and Title of the person the recommendation is being submitted by. c. Statement about the applicant.
	Personal Statement (approximately 500 words) Tell us about yourself, your interests in science and engineering as a future STEM professional, and your academic and career goals. What is it about your heritage/culture that makes you who you are? Specifically talk about what being Hispanic means to you and how it shapes your life and your future goals.
	Signed declaration by applicant (see below)
