Medication Drop-Off:

• Parents/guardians will be invited to "drop off" medications on Thursday, August 31st between 8:30 a.m.- 2:30 p.m.

Transportation Related Information

Student Arrival & Dismissal Via Bus:

- Buses will arrive at CMS at approximately 7:35 a.m.; students will disembark beginning at 7:40 a.m.
- Students will disembark (one bus at a time) following directions provided by middle school staff.
- Students will be dismissed from their period 9 classes at 2:38 p.m.

Student Arrival & Dismissal Via Parent/Guardian Transport:

- Please note that students being transported by their parents/guardians may be "dropped off" at the Main Entrance (in the front of the building) beginning at 7:10 a.m.
- Students will not be permitted to enter the building prior to 7:10 a.m.
- Students will enter the building and be directed to the New Cafeteria, North Cafeteria or South Cafeteria.
- At 7:40 a.m., students will be dismissed from the above locations and sent directly to their period one/homeroom classrooms
- Students will be dismissed from their period 9 classes at 2:38 p.m.

Retrieving Students from School (during the school day):

- The parent/guardian or another adult (who must be listed in your students Infinite Campus Portal) must report to the building with identification.
- The parent/guardian must enter the building through security and "sign their child out."

Retrieving Students from School (after school):

- Parents/guardians who are picking up their child at the 2:38 p.m. dismissal, will do so in the main parking lot.
- Parents/guardians who are picking up their child at 3:30 p.m. or 5:00 p.m., will do so in the rear lot which can be accessed by the entrance just west of the main entrance.

Late Bus Information:

- Late buses will depart from CMS at 3:40 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. daily.
- There are 4 different late bus routes (routes A, B, C and D).

Student Arrival on September 5th (grade 6 only):

- Grade 6 students will be actively supported as they navigate their way to their first period classroom on September 5th.
- As students exit the bus, all grade 6 students will meet their period 1 teacher in the bus parking lot.

- o In the event of inclement weather, we will ensure that all grade 6 students are brought directly to their teacher's classroom.
- Grade 6 students who arrive via parent/guardian transportation will be directed to the auditorium and arranged according to their period 1 teacher.
 - From the auditorium, students will be escorted to their period 1 classroom.
- Students, all we ask is that you remember the name of your period 1 teacher, we will guide you from there!

Orientation Plans (grade 6 only):

- In addition to the New Student Summer Orientation on Monday, August 28th and subsequent building access days on August 29th and August 30th, grade 6 students will have an additional orientation experience on September 5th.
- Please note that all grade 6 students will have an opportunity to tour the building and will be orientated to life at CMS throughout their first day at CMS.

Student Lunches/ "Split" Lunch Program:

- Students will be assigned a lunch period noted as either "Gold" or "White" on their schedules.
- Schedules will be available via the Infinite Campus Parent Portal after 12:00 p.m. on August 24, 2023.

Students with the "Gold" Designation:

- Will report to the cafeteria for the first part of the period in order to participate in food service/ lunch.
- After approximately 20 minutes, students with the "Gold" designation will report to recess/ recreation.

Students with the "White" Designation:

- Will report directly to recess/ recreation.
- After approximately 20 minutes, students with the "White" designation will report to the cafeteria to participate in food service/ lunch.

Please note that students <u>will</u> have the opportunity to adjust their "Gold" or "White" designation, after the conclusion of the first week of school. The process for doing so will be discussed with students during their assigned lunch period. If approved, parents/guardians will be notified via school messenger regarding changes to their child's schedule.

Students interested in a quiet space to read or complete school work will be permitted to report to the cafeteria adjacent to the main cafeteria, rather than outdoor recreation/ recess. This location will be supervised by middle school staff and presents an additional option for students.

Students enrolled in Lunch Chorus:

- As in years past, the Lunch Chorus program will commence toward the end of September.
- Students enrolled in Lunch Chorus will report to the Chorus Room (A-9) during their designated "Recess" time.

Clubs at CMS:

- There are a variety of clubs and activities for students to join at CMS. It is our hope that students take advantage of these opportunities throughout their time at CMS.

ChromeBooks

- Students will be expected to bring their fully charged ChromeBook to school every day. When not being used in classes, students should keep their ChromeBook in their assigned locker.
- In the event that your child does not have their ChromeBook or their device is damaged/defective, a loaner device will be issued.
 - Please understand that replacement/loaner devices will be issued as promptly as possible, however this is predicated on supply.
- Staff members will be available in room C2-18 throughout the school day to issue loaner devices.
- Parents/guardians and students will assume the responsibility for any <u>intentionally</u> damaged Chromebook(s).
 - The cost to replace an intentionally damaged device will be \$300.00.
 - Further, intentionally damaged devices *may* result in a Dean's Office Referral.
