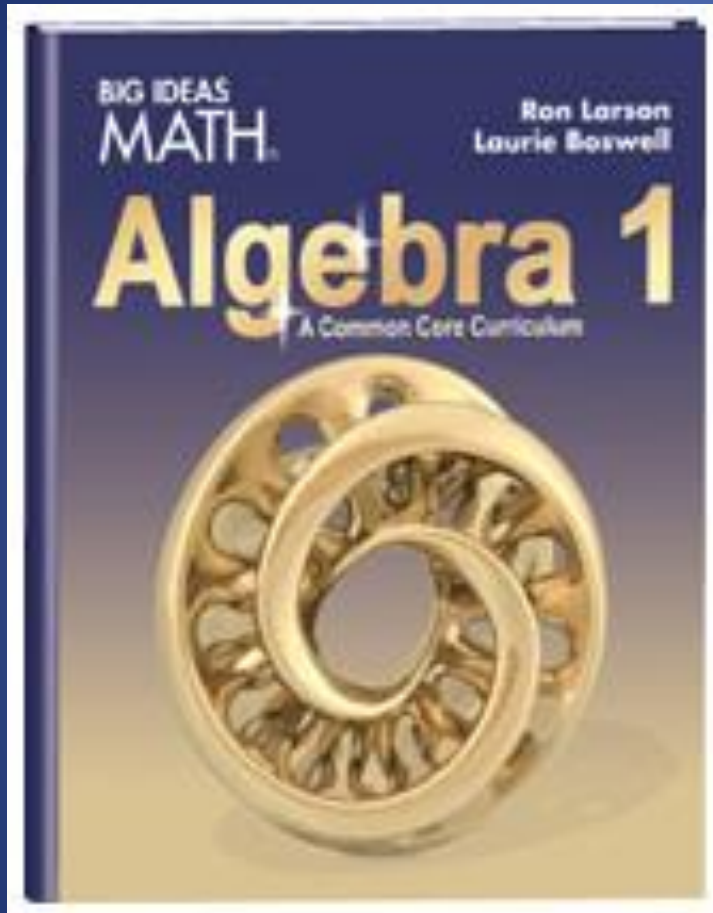

Grades

- Tests – given at the end of each unit. They will be cumulative.
- Quizzes – to reinforce individual concepts that have been recently taught.
- In-class projects – allowing students to apply the concepts.
- Completion of homework!!

Grades, continued!

- 90% of the Marking Period Grade is determined by dividing the total number of points earned on tests, quizzes, and in-class projects by the total number of points possible for that marking period, then multiplying by 100.
- 10% of the Marking Period Grade is determined by homework. Homework is checked regularly. On occasion, homework will be collected and graded. Having a working graphing calculator is always part of the homework assignment.

PARENT PORTAL

We now have “open gradebook” on Infinite Campus. Parents can access their child’s grades at any time during the marking period, not just when report cards are distributed!

I respectfully suggest that you take advantage of the opportunity to monitor your child’s progress through Infinite Campus.
