Non-teamed classes:

- **Art:** marble notebook
- **FACS:** 3 ring binder (suggested size: 1")
- **Health:** 3 ring binder (suggested size: 1"); heavy duty folder
- **Technology:** none

Students should bring the following to all classes:

- loose leaf paper in binders
- school-issued agenda
