Bowlero only collected payment for the initial 75 students leaving an overage of fees collected at \$345.00. Discussion on the liability of a PTA member holding on to the funds. It was agreed that the PTA would reach out to the PTA Council for guidance in this matter.

It was discussed about the possibility of using the overage funds as a deposit for the next 7<sup>th</sup> Grade event.

#### • Open Gradebook

Teaching staff voiced concerns about how attendance is logged in. Some issues with students being marked absent for the full day instead of just individual periods. This item was **tabled** to allow for follow-up with appropriate staff.

**Student Accounts**: Committee agreed at this time Student Accounts would be counterproductive in that the open access to grades could possibly cause anxiety to individual students.
