Dual Enrolled College-Level Courses

- College-level courses carry college credit that may be transferred and applicable towards a degree at other colleges or universities
- College credit registration instructions will be shared by the classroom teacher
- Each institution has specific eligibility requirements, registration procedures and payment deadlines that must be followed to ensure proper registration and receipt of credit
- In the event that a student chooses to withdraw from a college course, they must follow the deadlines and withdrawal procedures established by the credit-granting institution

To receive college credit for courses taken at Commack High School, students must request transcripts directly from the Registrar's Office of the college/university granting the credit. Links for transcript requests can be found on the "Academic Programs" >> "College Courses" website. See reverse.
