

Choir Binder Expectations

This is your choir binder.

Please read the following choir binder expectations.

This paper is to stay in your binder.

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- Your binder is yours! You are responsible for it while you are in the choir room.
- When you come to choir, you are to have your binder, and be in your chair by the time the bell rings.
- Binders are to stay in the choir room. This will keep them from getting lost.
- You are responsible for having copies of all music, hand-outs and warm-ups in your binder. When a new piece is passed out, you are responsible for placing it in your binder.
- Binders are part of your grade. Occasionally, I will be checking your binders after you leave the chorus room. I will look to see that all of your music is in your binder, that your binder is put in its proper spot, and that you are marking your music as I have asked in choir.
- The last two minutes of class, I will ask you to put your binder away. You are responsible for making sure your binder is put away in its proper spot. Remember! It's part of your grade to have your binder put away in the proper spot. If it's left out, and I have to put it away for you, you will not receive your binder points for the day.
