Applicants or Prospective Members

"In the first year of membership, the applicant must attend the initial meeting of the Honor Society to obtain information about membership. In the months prior to the induction ceremony, the applicant must earn **five** points by attending available meetings or activities of the Honor Society to show his/her intent on becoming a member. This period of time is referred to as the "probationary period" of the applicant. Applicants not fulfilling this requirement may be considered for membership."

Existing Members

"A member will remain in 'Good Standing' in the Honor Society when s/he obtains ten points each school year. Members must accumulate at least **five** points in each given year to attend the Induction Ceremony held in the Spring of each school year. Failure to accumulate said points will not result in being placed on probationary status, but will result in members not being able to attend the Ceremony."

Participation

As of today, we are just short of the one hundredth day of school. As of this point, the NTHS has posted 51 different opportunities to earn service points, and currently 33 of 50 members/applicants have logged fewer than 3.5 service hours.

Existing members, or prospective members who do not meet the minimum service requirements prior to ceremony will <u>not</u> be invited to the Ceremony.

The NTHS will not "create" last-minute service

Participation

The NTHS will not "create" last-minute service opportunities, extend deadlines, nor permit masses of students to over register for service events.
