In place of traditional ranking, in September, at the end of the first semester, and again in June of the senior year, we will calculate a weighted and unweighted grade point average for each student. These averages will then be recorded on student transcripts. Also located on the Senior Student Transcripts will be a Cohort/Grade Conversion Table. The presence of this table will permit colleges to place students in a particular “Cohort Group.” This table in combination with a student’s weighted grade point average will permit colleges to determine where an applicant stands relative to his/her classmates. Academic standing will thus be demonstrated without displacing other students who are achieving at approximately the same level.
