Dear Parents/Guardians:

The Halloween Parade for Indian Hollow students will commence at **2:30 p.m.** on **Friday, October 29, 2021.** Our students will walk around the school in a clockwise direction beginning at the front kindergarten door. In order to avoid congestion in front of the school, parents are requested to stay to watch the entire parade and to observe the parade from the following locations:

- Kindergarten - back of the school by the gymnasium
- Grade 1 - front of the school
- Grade 2 - north side of the school by the 2nd grade wing

Should we encounter inclement weather, the parade and any other Halloween related activities will be rescheduled for Monday, November 1, 2021. We will do our best to notify the community of our intentions the afternoon of October 28, 2021.

Since numerous visitors are expected for this event, carpooling is strongly advised, as parking space is limited. We anticipate the parade will last 15 to 20 minutes. If you choose to take your child home, please follow these guidelines:

- Grade 1 and Grade 2 - One masked parent may enter the school after all children have returned to their classrooms utilizing the main entrance and the rear side entrance near the gymnasium to sign your child out at their classroom door. Grade 1 please leave through the front K door and Grade 2 please leave through the Grade 2 door.
- Kindergarten parents may sign out their child at their child's classroom exterior door.
- Remaining students will be dismissed at our regular times.

Please refrain from sending in your child with a costume or mask that is scary for children 5-7 years of age. Also, **do not** send in any weapons, even if it's part of your child's costume. Please be reminded dogs are not permitted on school premises.

In order to ensure the physical safety of all our students, please refrain from sending in any food items and items that may be a choking hazard for distribution to your child's classmates/friends. Thank you in advance ~ Indian Hollow's SBMT 2019.
