We recommend both the ACT and the SAT. Students have the option of selecting which SAT and ACT scores they wish to submit to colleges. Juniors should not have scores sent to colleges at this time. The test results arrive approximately six weeks after each test administration. **In addition, it is highly recommended that students register for these exams as early as possible in order to ensure Commack High School as their testing site.**
