- 2. Scholarship applicants must have GPA of 3.0 or better.
- 3. Scholarship applicants must plan on seeking a Baccalaureate Degree.
- 4. Applicants are required to submit:
  - a. Completed, signed application.
  - b. A letter of recommendation from someone who is familiar with your community service work, for example a teacher, a guidance counselor or community leader.
  - c. Current, official transcript.
  - d. Typed essay (minimum of 500 words) Topic: "What Community Service means to me."
- 5. All components of application must be received by 11:59pm on May 1, 2024.

- 7. Interviews with semi-finalists will take place virtually during the week of May 6, 2024.
