Dear Parents/Guardians of Sophomores and Juniors,

On October 15, 2022 your child took the PSAT/NMSQT at Commack High School. The PSAT/NMSQT Score Report provides summaries of your child's performance on each section and content area so that students can see which skills they need to develop further.

Students will need to create a College Board account at <https://studentscores.collegeboard.org> so they can easily access their scores online and unlock a robust set of personalized resources to help them interpret their scores. If your child entered an email when taking the exam, the College Board sent an email to all test takers that included information on how your child can access their PSAT scores through the College Board's online reporting portal. For students who did not enter their email on test day, there is an access code on the attached score report for your child. PSAT scores will also be available on each student's Naviance account, although the in-depth score report is only available through their individual College Board account.
