Dear Parents/Guardians of Sophomores and Juniors,

On October 14, 2023 your child took the digital PSAT/NMSQT at Commack High School. Scores will be released to students beginning Monday, November 6 through Thursday, November 16. The PSAT/NMSQT score report provides summaries of your child's performance on each module and content area so that students can see which skills they need to develop further.

The easiest way for students to get alerted to their PSAT/NMSQT score report is by downloading the BigFuture School Mobile App – which will send a notification to all students by November 16. If your child entered a cell phone number during the Digital Readiness Check, the College Board will send a communication to test takers with information on how to access scores through BigFuture School. Students will need to create a College Board account at <https://studentscores.collegeboard.org> so they can easily access their scores as well as personalized test preparation resources. If students did not enter their cell phone number, students can request a hard copy of their scores from the Counseling Center.
