Dear Wood Park Families,

Today we introduced the Wood Park students to our school-wide positive behavior support system, The Principal's 200 Club. This program involves catching kids "being good" or showing expected behaviors throughout the school day and then publicly recognizing them for their behavior. Each week, teachers are given a set number of Principal's 200 Club Tickets, which are handed out to students showing expected behaviors. When a student gets a ticket, they then go to the security desk to choose a number from 1 – 200. Their name is then written on our Principal's 200 Club board on that number, which is displayed in the main hallway. The students also earn a special pencil to take home. When all of the numbers in a row or column fill up with names, all of the kids in that row or column earn a special "mystery motivator" reward (similar to Bingo). All students who are on the board also earn a Principal's 200 Club Certificate. Once we have a winning row or column, the board is erased and the process begins again.

We are very excited to be able to implement this program this year at Wood Park and look forward to seeing everyone's name on the Principal's 200 Club board! Please do not hesitate to reach out with any questions.
