Arrival and Dismissal

- During the first few days of school, we have many volunteers who assist with morning arrival. Please remember to remain on the grassy areas and keep the sidewalks free at all times. - If there is a change in your dismissal plan, parents must provide the classroom teacher with a note that clearly identifies the dismissal changes <u>including the first</u> and last name of the new designee picking up.

- Starting the day on time is imperative. We encourage parents to drop off children on time. Students should arrive at school no later than 9:15AM.
- Please try to schedule after school events after the close of the school day. Leaving early can be disruptive to the instructional day.
- Walker pick-up area will be located outside of the second grade wing. The door will open at 3:20 PM.
- Please carry picture ID at all times when entering the school.
- If you are utilizing the quick drop-off in the AM, please DO NOT EXIT your vehicle. The children should exit independently from the driver's side. Traffic build up on New Highway poses as a safety issue for all! Thank you~



Inclement Weather



In the event of a school closing, the school district's School Messenger system will contact all families during the morning hours. It is imperative that you inform the school of any phone number changes that occur during the school year. In order for you to receive a phone call, we need your most recent and updated information.
