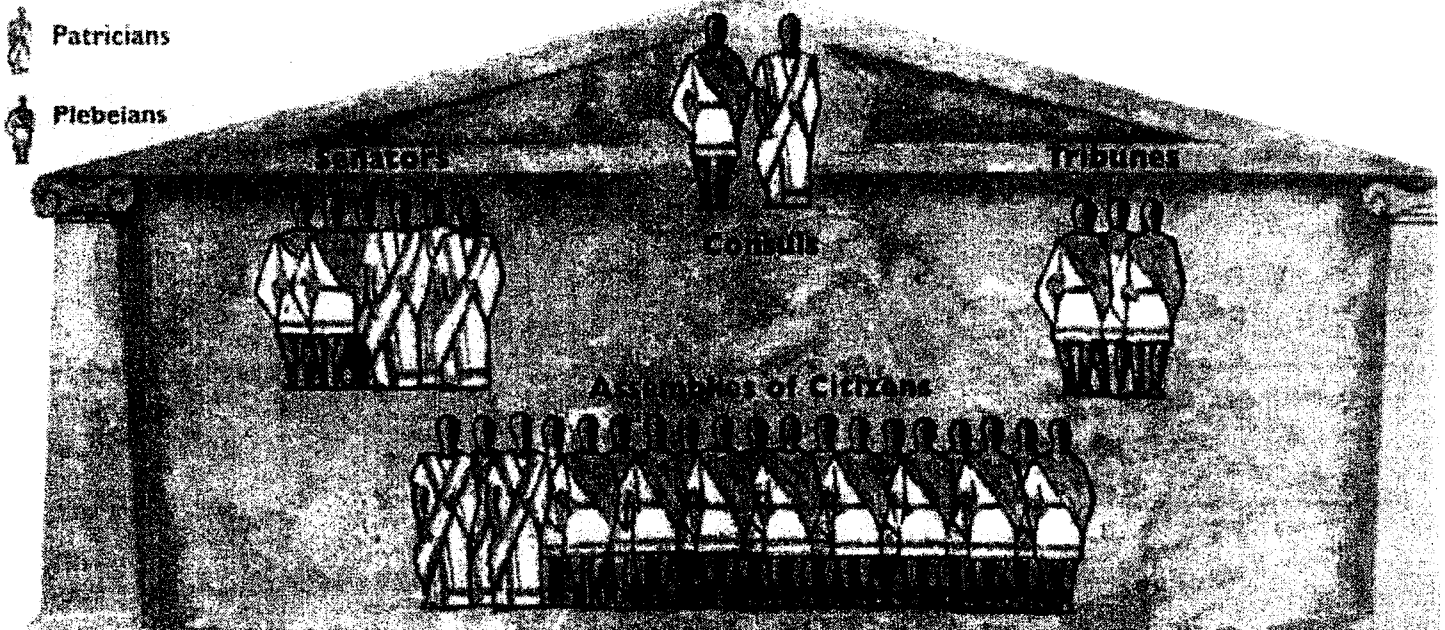

Republic - representative form of government.

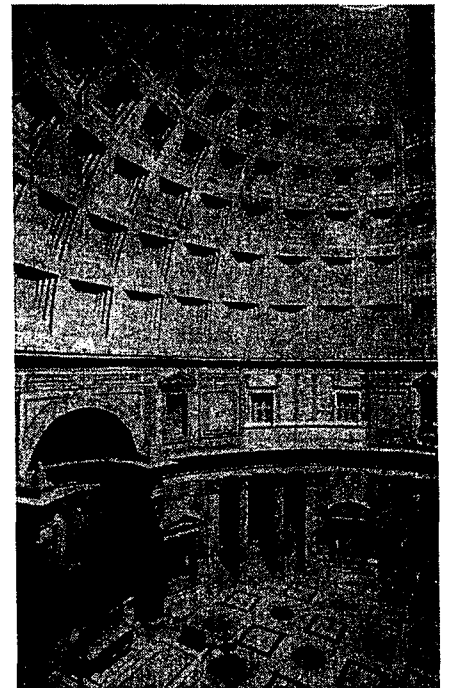
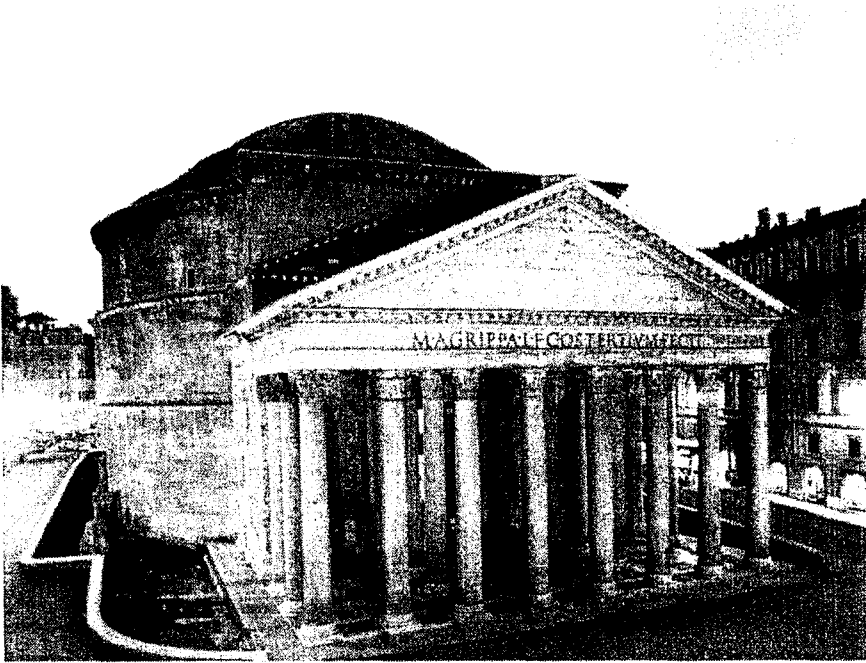
2 Consuls controlled the army, elected to one-year terms by the assembly.
